

Who are We?

Prayer 2000 is a partnership of Prayer Ministries that was created to sufficiently raise the awareness, the need for, and the Prayer Level throughout the Country in order to facilitate the revival, reformation, transformation and restoration of our nation.

“Judges 20: 26- 28 Then all the Israelites, the whole army, went up and came to the house of God [Bethel] and wept; and they sat there before the Lord and fasted that day until evening and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings before the Lord. ²⁷ And the Israelites inquired of the Lord—for the ark of the covenant of God was there [at Bethel] in those days, ²⁸ And Phinehas son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron, ministered before it in those days—saying, Shall we yet again go out to battle against our brethren the Benjamites or shall we quit? And the Lord said, Go up, for tomorrow I will deliver them into your hand”.

The partnership includes a wide and varied cross-section of Christians that represent numerous denominations, Umbrella Groups, Ministers’ Fraternals, Prayer Groups and Ministries, and Churches. These Christians are driven by a passion to effect change in the Society through the amazing power of Intercessory prayer and fasting and to create an atmosphere that will attract the Presence; the Attention; and the Favour of God in transforming revival, nationwide. The partners have been meeting consistently since August of 1999.

As indicated by our Vision and Mission Statements, we accept responsibility to change the spiritual atmosphere and climate in our Nation through corporate prayer and intercession and to break and demolish the enemies influence through strategic spiritual warfare and informed intercession. Strategies are developed through Spiritual Mapping a process of consultation and partnering with the Ministers Fraternals, Pastors, and other Prayer Ministries. Prayer agendas are developed and seasons for intercession are scheduled and carried out on a per parish basis.

We are guided by some basic Scriptures passages such as:

(A) Isaiah 61: 6-8 NIV I have posted watchmen on your walls, O Jerusalem ([Jamaica](#)); they will never be silent day or night. You who call on the LORD, give yourselves no rest, ⁷ and give him no rest till he establishes Jerusalem ([Jamaica](#)) and makes her the praise of the earth. The LORD has sworn by his right hand and by his mighty arm: “Never again will I give your grain as food for your enemies, and never again will foreigners drink the new wine for which you have toiled;

(B) For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;

⁵ Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

⁶ And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled. 2 Cor. 10: 4-6 (KJV)

(C) I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men;

² For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.

³ For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; ⁴ Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. 1 Tim 2: 1-4 (KJV)

(D) ----I have heard thy prayer, and have chosen this place to myself for an house of sacrifice.

¹³ If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people;

¹⁴ If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. 2 Chron. 7: 12-14 (KJV).

(E) For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

¹³ Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Eph 6: 12-13 (KJV)

The increased willingness of the churches around the nation to meet corporately for sustained intercession is a definite outworking of Prayer 2000's Networking and Vision and Mission. The drive to experience national revival and transformation in our lifetime demands the total abandonment with expectation of self as well as the development of an appetite for humility, holiness, integrity, hunger for God, desperation, love, unity and obedience.

The highlight of our yearly activities is the Annual National "Healing the Land" Summit and Prayer Conference which is convened in all 14 Parishes of the Nation over the period 3rd January to 3rd February. This is normally held in 16 to 19 different locations and is facilitated jointly by approximately 90% of the churches in Jamaica; the Ministers Fraternal island wide; and other prayer ministries to include Reconciliation Ministries International; National Intercessory Prayer Network of Jamaica; The Prayer Cabinet; Aglow International; and Operation Save Jamaica.
